

Rules and Regulations:

Please read the following carefully and sign at the bottom to show that you have understood and complied with these rules and regulations.

1. This form must be completely filled out.
2. Nominees must be between the ages of 14 and 19 as of March 1st, 2010.
3. Innovations in all fields (science and technology, civil society, arts & culture, sports, etc) will be considered by the Prize Committee.
4. Only one winner will be chosen.
5. The total prize package is US \$10,000, split as follows: The winner will receive US \$5,000 for his or her personal use and US\$4,000 for enhancing his or her project for the community, The first person to nominate the winner will receive US\$1,000. If the winner nominates him/herself, then the US\$1,000 nominator prize will be added to the winner's US\$5,000 for personal use.
6. Nominators may not submit more than one form, unless instructed specifically to re-submit by the Prize Committee. Multiple submissions from one Nominator will lead to the disqualification of that person.
7. Nominations will be catalogued by date and time of arrival. When more than one nomination exists for the same nominee, the first nomination to arrive will be the nomination that is accepted for judgement and for the awarding of prizes.
8. Nominees must have generated the innovative idea on their own.
9. Innovative ideas must be verifiable. Finalists must be in a position to show judges their project and demonstrate thorough knowledge of how they implemented the project.
10. All entries received before the closing date will be judged by a Prize Committee. Decisions of the Prize Committee are final.
11. The Prize Committee will be formed and continue at the discretion of Joy FM in conjunction with African Leadership Academy.
12. On or after April 15, 2010, finalists will be contacted by the Prize Committee. Shortly thereafter, the list of finalists will be posted on www.myjoyonline.com and www.africanleadershipacademy.org
13. Finalists will be interviewed on Joy FM and affiliate channels of the Multi Media Group explaining their innovation to the Ghanaian Public.
